Dates: Tuesday 26th September 2017 and Friday 29th September 2017

Registration for the Spring Term will be held at the same venue on Monday 8th January 2018 from 11.00 -13.00

Fees can only be paid in cash. We are unable to accept credit/debit cards or cheques. The fee entitles all members to participate in as many group activities as they wish (subject to availability).

The Registration desk will be open at Lux Mundi on the days shown between 10.30 -13.00 each day.

If you are unable to register on either of these days you will be able to do so at the Registration Desk on Group Enrolment Day (page 4), where you will receive your membership card.

Those unable to attend on any of these dates should contact the Group Leader to check availability.

Guest and Visitor Fees and Changes to Programme
